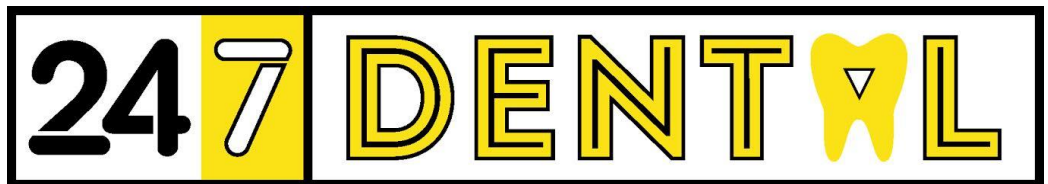
Goblets of Fire
