Dear Parents/Carers

This morning the Premier of Victoria, Mr Daniel Andrews and the Minister for Education, Mr James Merlino announced a phased return to face-to-face teaching on school premises with the following timeline.

There will be more information coming in the next couple of days to answer some of the questions you may have around the following arrangements.

Monday 25 May, Pupil free day.

25/05, Teachers will return to school and prepare for the resumption of face-to-face learning. No work will be provided online and no remote classes will occur on this day.

Tuesday 26 May, F-2 Onsite

Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 students will return to school on this day and commence face-to-face learning with social distancing measures in place.

Tuesday 9 June, Y3-6 Onsite

All Year 3-6 students return to face-to-face teaching in the classroom on this day. All remote learning will cease as of Friday June 6th.

Other Measures

We will be limiting the people who are able to access the school. There will be no camps, excursions, incursions, assemblies, interschool sport until otherwise advised.

Students are advised to bring their own water bottles on the resumption of school.

Cleaning

The cleaning protocols that had been put in place in the last weeks of term one (being the targeting of high touch point areas throughout the school), will continue for the remainder of term two and for term three. We will:

- Continue our roving sanitiser routine increasing frequency on all high touch areas, including door entry/exits points and especially targeting staff and student toilet areas, i.e. press buttons to toilets, wash basins, taps, cubicle doors and the like.
- Employ additional cleaning staff who will assist our team in ensuring all student/staff tables and chairs and high touch points are targeted and continue to be sanitised each day.
- Have in place special procedures for spills and the handling of the same.

I sincerely thank the school community for their support of the online/remote learning arrangements that have been in place for term two and I look forward to your continued support as we phase back into face-to-face teaching at Cheltenham East Primary. As has been the case throughout the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, we will continue to update you as information comes to hand.
