



## Onsite Remote Learning Supervision

### Advice from the Department of Education

To increase physical distancing across the population and slow the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19), students in Victorian government schools in Prep to Year 10, except those students enrolled in Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) programs and those students enrolled in special schools, must move to remote and flexible learning from July 20th, Term 3.

The following operating model will apply. All students will be learning from home, except for students in the following categories:

- a. Students enrolled in Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) programs and those students enrolled in special schools
- b. Children on days when they are not able to be supervised at home and no other arrangements can be made. This will be available for children of parents who cannot work from home, any student with a disability and vulnerable children (at the Principal's discretion), including:
  - children in out-of-home care
  - children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm
  - children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).

## CEPS ONSITE REMOTE LEARNING SUPERVISION BOOKING PROCESS

If your child meets the above requirements and a booking for onsite supervision during the school week is requested:

1. A link to the online Onsite Supervision Application will be posted to Classroom Dojo each Wed 12pm and remain online until Sunday 5pm. Please fill out and submit this form.
2. You will receive an email confirming your booking for the following week, prior to Sunday 6pm.

*Students attending school must wear their uniform and bring their drink bottle, as the drinking taps are not operational. All supervision will take place in the BER/Library building.*

*Students should use Gate 3, Coolac Street, to report directly to the BER/Library at 9am for temperature checking and hand sanitizing. The only entry/exit gate in operation for supervised students is Gate 3, Coolac Street. Students will be dismissed from this gate at 3.30pm unless otherwise noted.*
