## Roadmap to Easing COVID-19 Restrictions in Schools

Dear Parents

Given the announcement made by the Premier of Victoria, Daniel Andrews and the Minister for Education, James Merlino yesterday, I will outline below, the arrangements that will be in place until further notice. The Education Department is yet to release additional working details. As has been our practice we will forward these on when they become available and how they will impact the Cheltenham East Primary School community.

### Remainder of Term 3 (Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September – Friday 18<sup>th</sup> September)

No change to current arrangements. Remote and flexible learning for all year levels. On-site supervision for children of permitted workers and vulnerable students will continue to be provided consistent with existing guidelines.

### Week 1 Term 4 (Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October)

No change to current arrangements. Remote and flexible learning for all year levels.

### Week 2 Term 4 (Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October onwards)

Students in Foundation to Year 2 return to full-time on-site schooling. The existing remote learning program will not continue for these year levels.

On-site supervision for children of permitted workers and vulnerable students will continue to be provided for Year 3-6 children consistent with existing guidelines.

Remote and flexible learning will continue for all students in Year 3 to Year 10, other than for children of permitted workers and vulnerable students.

### Year 3 – 10 students – Onsite Face to Face Learning

All students from Year 3 to Year 10 in metropolitan Melbourne will continue with remote and flexible learning. Please note: A date for the return of these year levels to face-to-face learning will be subject to further health advice.
