What is the Color Me event? This is CEPS's newest fundraiser where families, friends and neighbors pledge money to support the students as they walk laps around our school on Creative Arts Day. The walkathon will take place on November 30, 2018 beginning on the oval.

Y3-6: 2.30-2.50PM

YF-2: 2.50-3.20PM

100% of the money raised goes directly to the continued funding of the perimeter fence.

CEPS students will wear a white t-shirt and walk laps around the route: oval/basketball courts/veggie patch/asphalt/silver street stairs/returning to the oval, while their teachers and volunteers gently throw colored cornstarch on their shirts. It will make a *colorful* mess on the shirts, but doesn't hurt at all. It is like getting into a powdered sugar food fight. The powder is food grade quality, 100% nontoxic, completely biodegradable, colored cornstarch.

How do we raise money? Prior to the walkathon, each student obtains pledges and donations in support of his/her efforts. Sponsors may sign up to pledge a flat dollar amount and/or a per lap donation. Money raised will go directly to the Parents Committee for the continued funding of the school perimeter fence.

Can I get involved? ABSOLUTELY! There are many opportunities to help out with this event before, during, and after! Look for information about volunteer sign-ups coming via your class reps and watch for more info on Class Dojo.

What do I do next? Please collect pledges and donations on your PLEDGE FORM attached. Ask family, relatives, friends, co-workers, employers, etc. for support. DON'T FORGET TO SIGN AND TURN IN YOUR PLEDGE FORM by Thursday, November 29th because it will also serve as permission for your child to participate.

FAQs

What should I wear the day of the event? Students are permitted to wear white clothing on this school day. It is Creative Arts Day at CEPS. It will be a lot of fun to start in white and end...**COLOUR-FABULOUS!** Students might like to carry a spare set of clothes in their bag to get into after the event. *If students are not permitted to participate in having colour thrown on them, they are asked to wear a black t-shirt for identification and skip around the colour station.*

Note: Students may want to wear sunglasses for eye protection, but it's not necessarily needed.

Will the color ruin clothes or running shoes? The color does mostly wash out after the event. As with anything dirty, the sooner you wash it the better. We suggest wearing items that you wouldn't mind getting **colorful**. If you would like to preserve the color in your running shirt, spray it with vinegar and iron it. But if you wash it....it eventually will come out.

How does the color affect the inside of cars? Most people bring some old towels for the insides of their cars, just in case. It's like driving home from the swimming pool in your swimsuit, just dirtier.

Are cameras and phones safe to have in the color zones? If you want to get shots right in the midst of the color we recommend covering cameras/phones with plastic wrap or a sandwich bag.
